
The First Lady Of Neo Soul: Erykah Badu's Journey To Stardom

In 1994, Badu signed a recording contract with Kedar Entertainment. Her debut album, *Baduizm*, was released in 1997 and was an instant critical and commercial success. The album spawned the hit singles "On & On," "Appletree," and "Next Lifetime," and won Badu a Grammy Award for Best Female R&B Vocal Performance. Badu's follow-up albums, *Mama's Gun* (2000), *Worldwide Underground* (2003), and *New Amerykah Part One (4th World War)* (2008), were also critically acclaimed and commercially successful.


